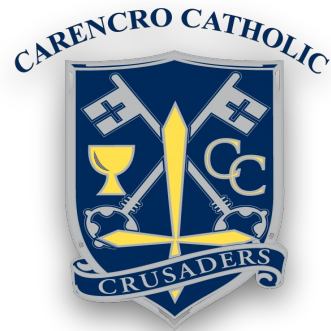


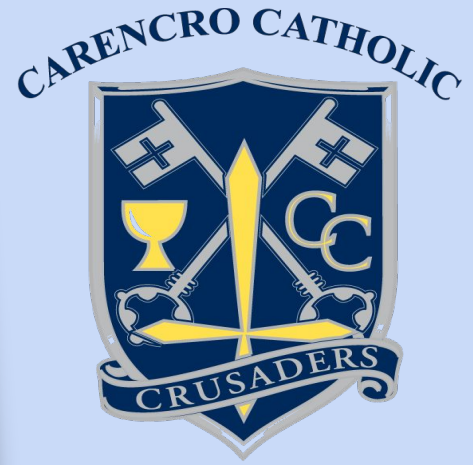
# Reopening Plan

### **Strong Start 2020 -**

- The Louisiana Dept. of Education & Louisiana Dept. of Health have issued guidance on Strong Start 2020.
- Each School District will create their own plans.
- Each school within the Diocese of Lafayette will write its own plan.
- Plans must be flexible and able to modify as needed.





# Phase details as it pertains to schools:

<b>Stay at Home Order</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Shelter at home. Limited movements outside of family residence</li><li>● Only essential personnel allowed on campus</li><li>● Distance Learning in place.</li></ul>
<b>Phase 1</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Maintain social distancing with groups of no more than 10 people</li><li>● Return to campus allowed</li></ul>
<b>Phase 2 (current phase)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Limited group sizes with no more than 25 people</li><li>● Schools remain open with restrictions</li></ul>
<b>Phase 3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Groups of less than 50 people</li><li>● Continue with precautions and protective measures</li></ul>

**Here at CCS, we have every intention of beginning the school year in the building on August 13, 2020 and to keep all students safely in school every day all year.**





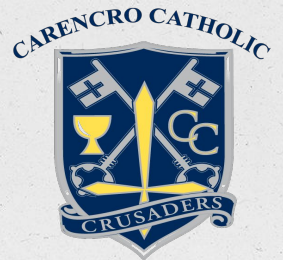
# How the Phases will look at CCS:

Stay at Home Order	Phase 1	* Phase 2-3
Off Campus	Hybrid	Traditional School
Essential staff only allowed on campus	10 allowed in classroom, M-F on campus	25 allowed in classroom, M-F on campus
Full time Distance Learning	Split homeroom classes. 1/2 day instruction, 1/2 day virtual	Full, traditional school day following guidelines



# School Building

- **Hand Sanitizing stations are being installed at 30 locations on campus.**
- **Bathrooms and well as playground equipment will be sanitized 3 times per day.**
- **Water Fountains are turned OFF. Students are allowed to bring one reusable water bottle from home to use for the day. Please label, reuse, and sanitize daily. Water bottles must stay at student desk.**



# Classroom Arrangement

- All Classrooms have been cleaned and sanitized.
- All desks will be placed in rows, all facing one direction. (no grouping)
- Students and teachers are required to sanitize their hands upon entering and exiting any room.
- Face masks are mandatory for grades 3-8 (as per Governor Edwards' newest mandate). Teachers are required to wear face masks when working directly with a student (closer than 6 ft. for 15 consecutive minutes).



# Before and After School Care

- **We will still offer before and after school care, beginning at 7:00 AM, ending at 5:45 PM.**
- **Social distancing measures will be in place.**
- **Specifics will be available during Meet & Greet.**

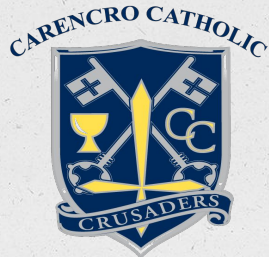




# Closed Campus

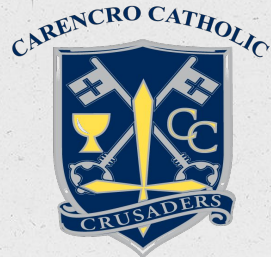
**We are a CLOSED campus!**

- **As much as we enjoy all of the visitors for Mass, lunch, and other classroom events, we must protect our students and staff members. Unnecessary exposure puts everyone at a greater risk. Our gates will be locked at the tardy bell (7:45). No one will be able to enter or exit until 2:55, with the exception of students who become ill. If for some reason your child needs to check out early for an appointment, please inform the office 24 hours prior.**



# School Lunch

- **We are prepared for 3 types of lunches:**
  - **Traditional hot meal, utilizing front and back of cafeteria to maintain social distancing.**
  - **Grab & Go type meal. Students will grab lunch in the line and return to their classrooms to eat .**
  - **Classroom Service where meals will be delivered directly to students in classrooms.**



# School Mass

- **Students will have Mass weekly.**
- **After speaking with Fr. Ledoux, we will have a hybrid Mass with some students in gym while the Mass is live streamed into other classrooms onto Promethean boards.**
- **All students who are able, will receive Holy Communion.**



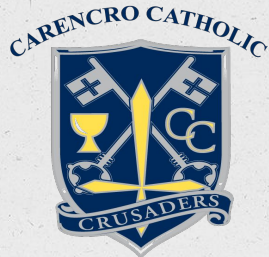
# Athletics
